Syntec plans Genesee County expansion

High-tech manufacturing company **Syntec Technologies Inc.** will add 35 to jobs to its payroll as part of an expansion in Genesee County.

The company will spend more than \$640,000 on the project, with the state making available \$150,000 through a capital grant from **Empire State Development**. The plant, located in the Town of Pavilion, will undergo \$300,000 in renovations. New equipment will be purchased at a cost of more than \$340,000, officials said.

The expansion plan comes after Syntec announced July 31 that it would merge with its subsidiary, Rochester Tool and Mold, under the name **Syntec Optics**.

Privately held Syntec makes polymer-optical products such as fingerprint and facial scanners, cameras and blood analyzers, which are used at airports, banks and hospitals for homeland security purposes.
