

SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing pursuant to Article 18-A of the New York General Municipal Law (the "Act") will be held by the Genesee County Industrial Development Agency d/b/a Genesee County Economic Development Center (the "Agency") on Thursday, June 3, 2021, at 10:00 a.m., local time, at Alabama Town Hall, 2218 Judge Road, Oakfield, New York 14125, in connection with the matter described below. **PLEASE NOTE THE SPECIAL PUBLIC HEARING INSTRUCTIONS INCLUDED AT THE END OF THIS NOTICE.**

Plug Power Inc., for itself or on behalf of an entity formed or to be formed by it or on its behalf (the "Company"), previously submitted an application (the "Application") to the Agency requesting that the Agency provide to the Company certain Financial Assistance for a Project as more fully described in a Notice of Public Hearing published in the *Daily News* on March 10, 2021. The public hearing being held on Thursday, June 3, 2021, supplements the public hearing held by the Agency on March 22, 2021 with respect to the Financial Assistance and the Project.

Subsequent to the public hearing held by the Agency on March 22, 2021, the Company submitted a modified Application to the Agency requesting that the Agency (i) increase the amount of Financial Assistance being contemplated by the Agency for the benefit of the Company, and (ii) modify and supplement the definition of Project to include *the acquisition, construction and equipping of an approximately 345kV to 115kV main substation* (the "Substation") in support of the planning, design, construction and operation of a green hydrogen production and distribution facility to located at 6840 Crosby Road in the Town of Alabama, New York.

The Agency contemplates that it will provide financial assistance to the Company to acquire, construct and equip the Substation in the form of a sales and use tax exemption for purchases and rentals related to the acquisition, construction, and equipping of the Substation.
