3. Discussions / Official Recommendations to the Board:

3a. Health Insurance – L. Farrell stated that she is bringing forward the conclusions of the health insurance analysis to the Committee. About every three years, the Agency needs to change carriers because another carrier will try to get into the market that offers better rates. 2026 will be our second year with Univera, so hopefully we would have one more year before needing to make a change. The Univera Health plan requested a 14.56% increase for 2026 but were only approved for a 10.12% increase. Tompkins compared the current plan we have to other plans with similar deductible amounts and out-of-pocket costs and Univera came back as the best option. We do anticipate this cost being within budget. The Committee agreed with L. Farrell's recommendation to stay with Univera's Health plan.

M. Gray asked what the EDC contribution will be for 2025 and L. Farrell stated she would have to look that up since the column for that was hidden on the spreadsheet. She also stated that for 2026 actual, she is projecting for potential changes that she's unsure will even happen, so the amount of the EDC contribution could be less.
