The purpose of this letter is to transmit the modified Part 182 Permit for the WWTF, Laydown Area, Substation and associated roads, and Powerline. This modification adds the construction of the powerline after November 1, 2022.

This letter also conveys the Department's Amended Findings Statement for all the above referenced permit.

Please read the enclosed permit and required conditions carefully, because many conditions require specific actions on your part, and let us know immediately if you believe there any conditions which cannot be met in full.

As you are aware, the Department continues to engage with the Tonawanda Seneca Nation (TSN) in on various projects including this modified permit. The Department notified TSN on September 29, 2022, that TSN had an opportunity to comment on and have discussions with the Department about the permit modification application provided they occur by October 28, 2022. Shortly before that date, TSN indicated that they would not be able to meet the specified timeframe and anticipated providing comments on the permit modification application to the Department by November 4, 2022. Should TSN provide comments, the Department will review them and, if changes to the modified permit are appropriate, the Department will work expeditiously with you to incorporate and/or address them.



Please note that under 6 NYCRR Part 621.10 of the Uniform Procedures Act, if a permit for a project is denied, or is issued with significant conditions attached and an adjudicatory public hearing was not held, then the applicant may request that one be held. Such a request must be made within 30 calendar days of the date of the mailing of either the notice of denial or the permit with conditions.
